



West Cork Photography Breaks Terms and Conditions 1

1. When you make a booking, you must complete the booking form, accepting on behalf of your party (if appropriate), the terms of these booking conditions, and pay a non-refundable deposit of £200 each.
2. The balance must be paid on receipt of the final invoice at least eight weeks before the departure date.
3. If the weekend is less than eight weeks away, then the full amount must be paid at the time of booking.
4. Cancellations must be made in writing, with the date of receipt determining the cancellation charges.
 - More than 28 days - 50%
 - 28 - 15 days - 70%
 - 15 days or less - 100%Cancellations may be covered under the terms of your own insurance policy.
5. By its nature the photography weekend requires flexibility by all parties and must allow for alternatives because of weather/local conditions etc. For this reason the outline itinerary and description must be taken as an indication of what may take place, and not as a contractual obligation.
6. In the unlikely event that Celia Bartlett is unable to attend due to illness or other circumstances beyond her control, she will endeavour to find a suitable replacement tutor/leader. If this proves impossible, the holiday may be cancelled and all money paid to Celia Bartlett will be reimbursed.
7. If a photography holiday is cancelled for reasons stated in clause 6, Celia Bartlett can not accept responsibility for any consequential loss to you however that loss is incurred.
8. Celia Bartlett reserves the right to change any of the prices, service or other particulars contained in the West Cork Photographic Weekends listing at any time. If this happens she will inform you immediately with the opportunity to cancel any contract between you and her.
9. Transfers are by arrangement with Celia Bartlett.
10. Celia Bartlett does not accept liability for any loss or additional expense caused by delay or interruption to travel services through weather conditions, civil disturbance, industrial action, strikes, wars, floods, sickness or force majeure. Such losses or additional expenses are the responsibility of the passenger. Force majeure represents unusual and unforeseeable circumstances such as war or the threat of war, riots, terrorist activity, civil strife, industrial disputes, natural or nuclear disaster, fire, flood or adverse weather conditions.
11. All participants must be physically and mentally fit for the proposed activities before arrival. If you have any doubts about this, please ask beforehand. Any medical conditions that may affect the running of the weekend should be mentioned when booking. This break may not be suitable for people with certain medical conditions.
12. These photography weekends mean you will be visiting a wide variety of outdoor and indoor locations. Some of these may entail an element of risk and, whilst every possible effort is made to ensure your safety, it is up to you to use your own judgement and sense in order to ensure your personal safety.
13. All clients must sign a disclaimer form stating that they take responsibility for their own personal actions and risk during the holiday.
14. Celia Bartlett does not accept responsibility or liability for death, bodily injury or illness caused to the client or any other person included on the booking form. Your own insurance policy must cover the eventuality of accident/illness/death and any repatriation costs.
15. You must communicate any perceived failure in the performance of this contract at the time to us and give us the opportunity to arrive at a satisfactory solution.
16. Celia Bartlett reserves the right to change or cancel a weekend if the required minimum number of two students is not reached. If the minimum number of bookings required to run a course is not met, and a course is cancelled for this reason, it will not be less than 21 days prior to departure. If a holiday is cancelled for this reason all money paid to Celia Bartlett, including your deposit, will be refunded, otherwise the deposit is non-refundable. Refunds payments will be limited to the total amounts paid to Celia Bartlett and she can not be liable for any consequential loss of any kind however that loss is incurred.

17. It is a term of the contract between us that you will obtain appropriate and full travel insurance cover before you set out on the break. The insurance must cover the loss, expenses and damages arising from, including but not limited to, the cancellation of the break (whether in whole or in part), personal accident, death and injury, medical and repatriation costs (for overseas holidays), loss of baggage and personal money and effects and flight cancellations and delays. It is a condition of booking that all travellers are covered by this comprehensive travel insurance and do not travel against medical advice. We cannot be responsible for costs you incur as a result of failing to take out insurance suitable for your needs. You are responsible for indemnifying us in full in the event that we incur any losses or expenses arising out of your failure to take out adequate insurance cover.

18. You must be prepared to show proof of your insurance cover at the time of paying the balance for your weekend. Celia Bartlett may require:

- Name of Insurance Company
- Insurance Policy Number
- Insurance Emergency or Hotline telephone number

19. Should it be required, clients must be in possession of a valid passport and all visas, permits and certificates, including medical certificates required for the whole of the journey and the client accepts responsibility for obtaining the same. In order to get reciprocal health care in EU, you need a valid EHIC card. For full details visit www.dh.gov.uk/travellers. All information and advice given by Celia Bartlett is given in good faith.

20. By signing (= submitting the booking form online), you are agreeing to accept all these conditions. The person who signs the booking form does so on behalf of all the individuals included on it, so that all are bound by the booking conditions.
